The Tea on THC campaign was created by the **Colorado School of Public Health** in response to a request from the Colorado General Assembly to review the scientific literature on the prevalence and health effects linked to use of concentrated THC products. To date, the research team has screened over 90,000 studies to elevate findings that guide policy recommendations and inform a statewide education campaign empowering youth, pregnant women, parents, mentors, educators, clinicians and community partners to make decisions about their health.
